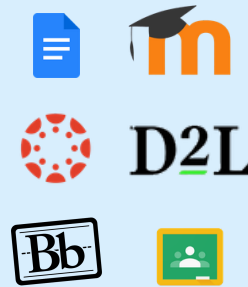


What is Process Feedback?

- It enables students to generate a *writing process report*
- Shows revisions, copy-paste events, and typing time
- Supports academic integrity through process transparency
- Works independent of AI policy

Editing time

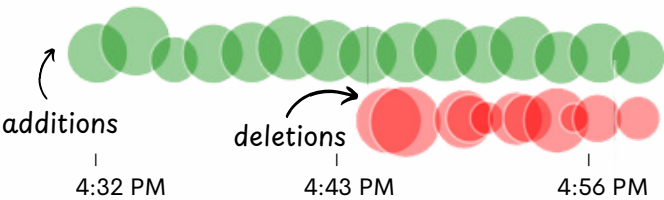
How long the student(s) was actively typing



Total Editing Time:
9 minutes

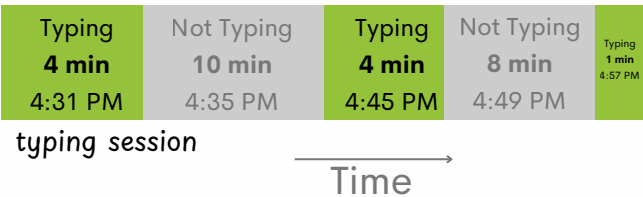
What was deleted, when

Size of the circle indicates # of characters



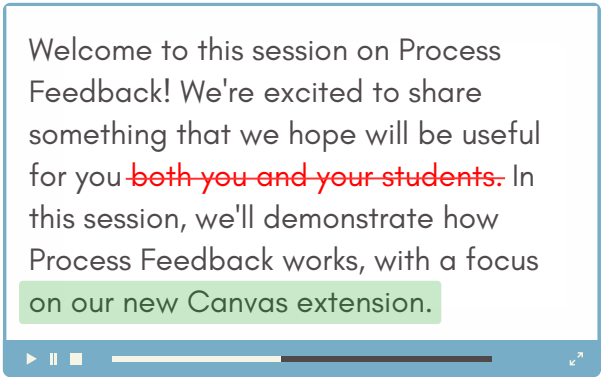
Typing sessions and breaks

Streaks of typing and not-typing durations



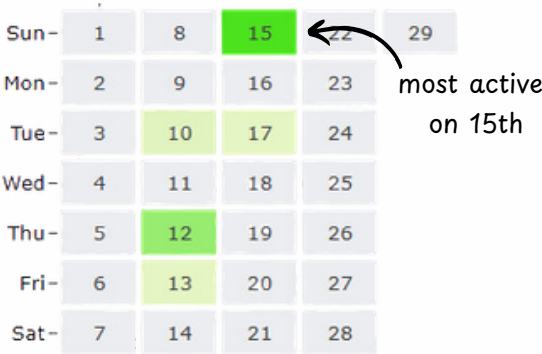
Typing replay

Shows the student's typing like a movie with options to play, pause, and slider options



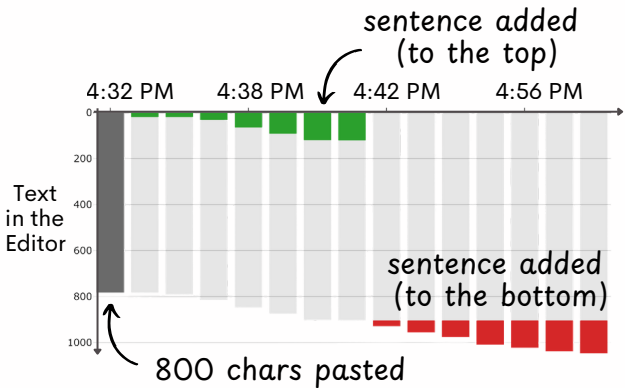
Active days on the task

Shows which days the student was active on the document (and how active)



Edit location in the editor

Shows which sentences were edited at which point in time



Paste events and time

Total paste actions: 3

1. At 4:32 PM, 800 characters were pasted
2. At 4:35 PM, 300 characters were pasted
3. At 5:01 PM, 120 characters were pasted

Author contributions

Author	Number of Changes
Student 1	37%
Student 2	20%
Student 3	43%

Two choices for teachers

- Option 1.** Ask students for their writing process report
- Option 2.** Ask students to share their reflections instead
